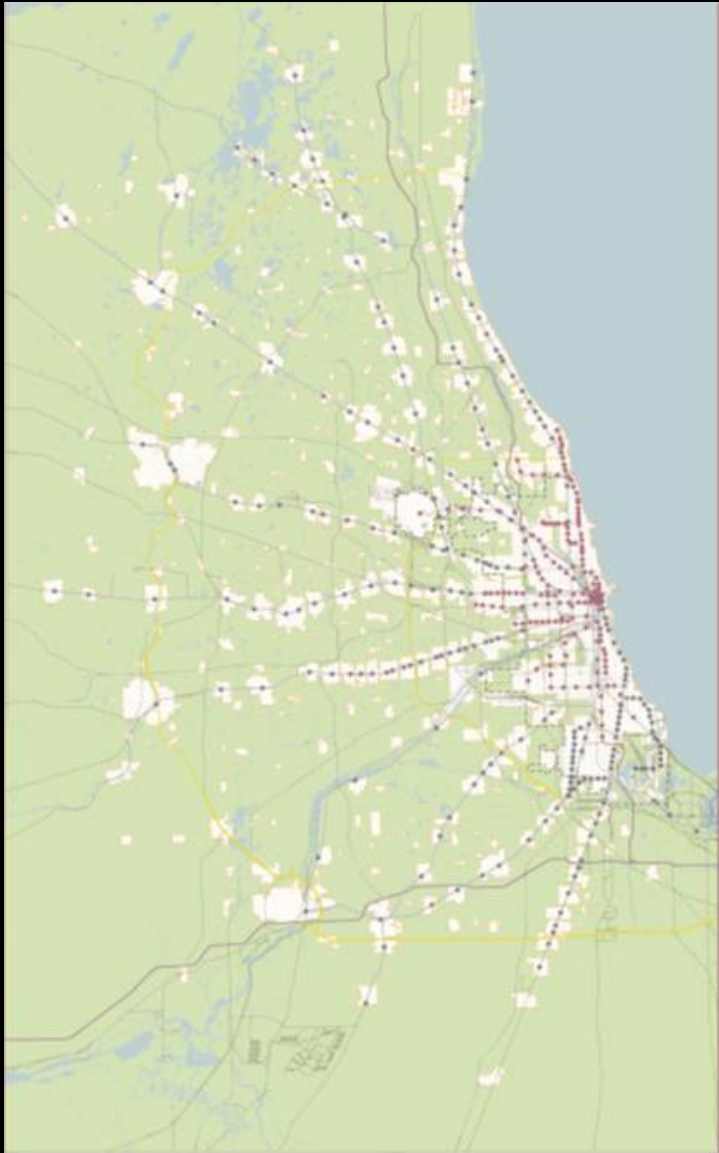

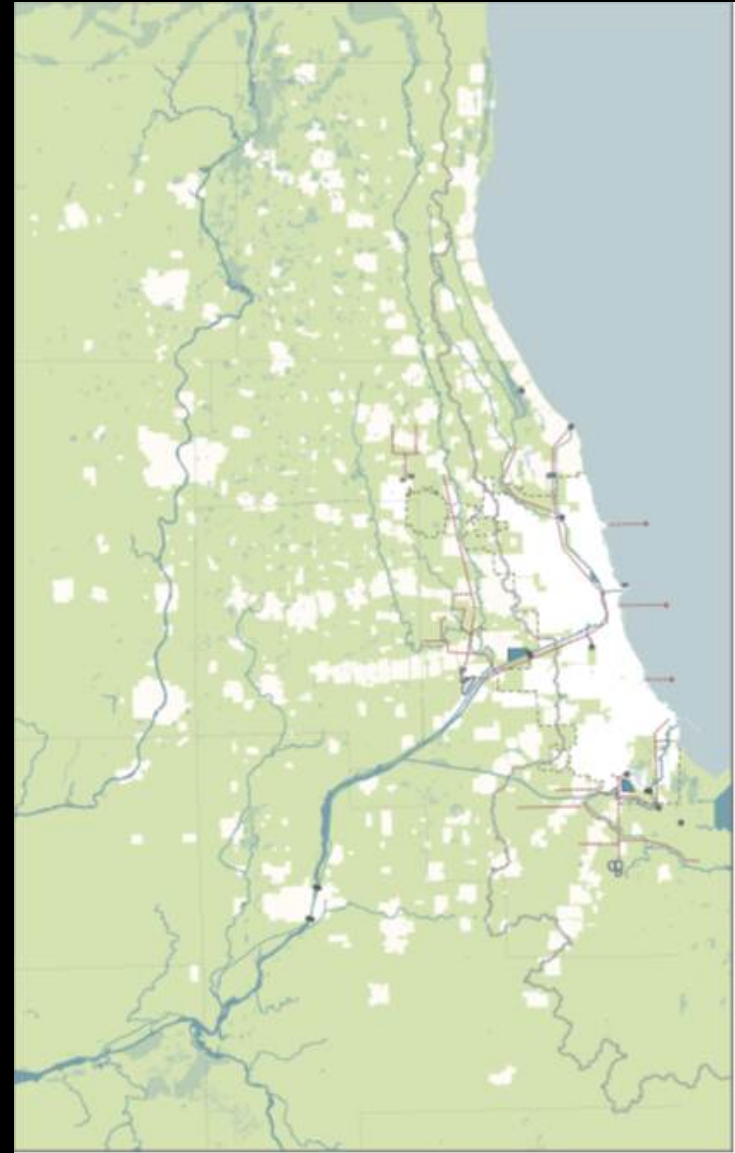

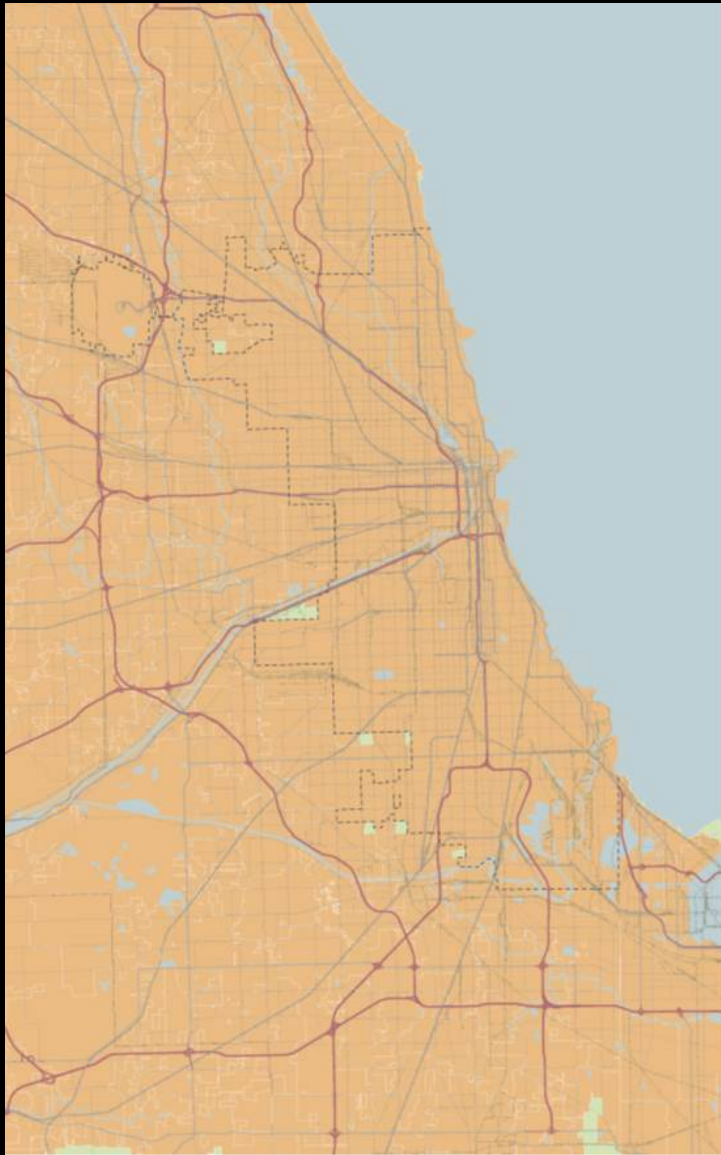


Proposed Vegetation

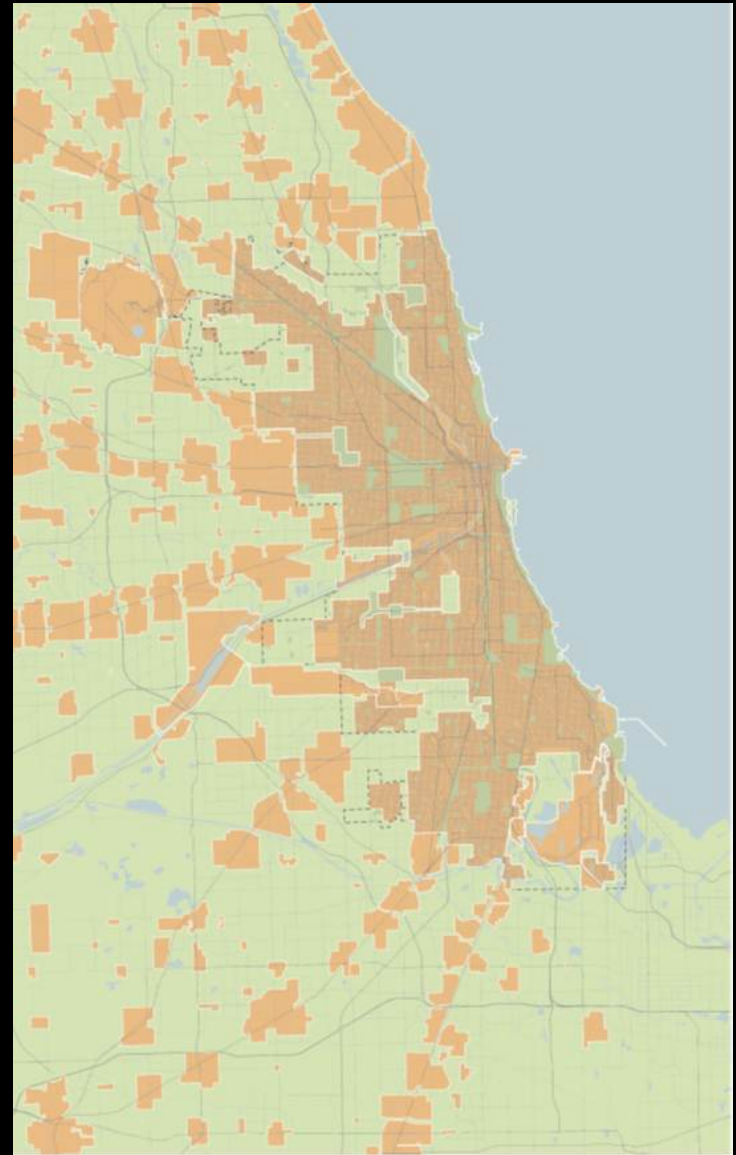


Proposed Water

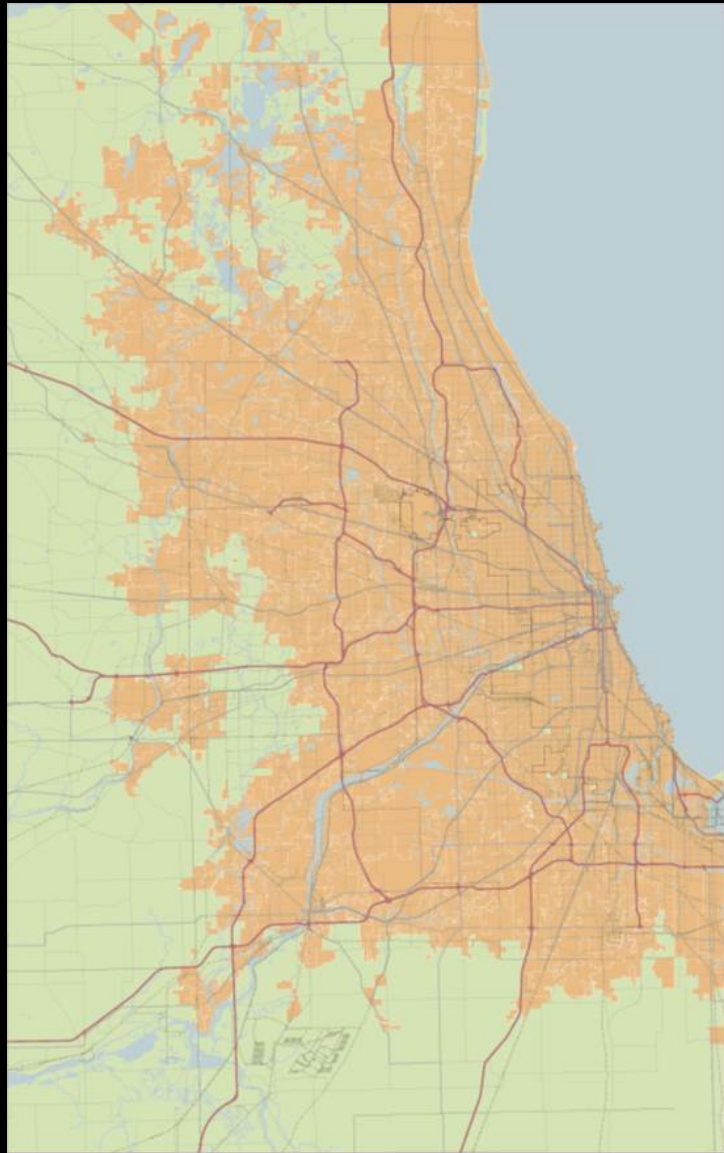

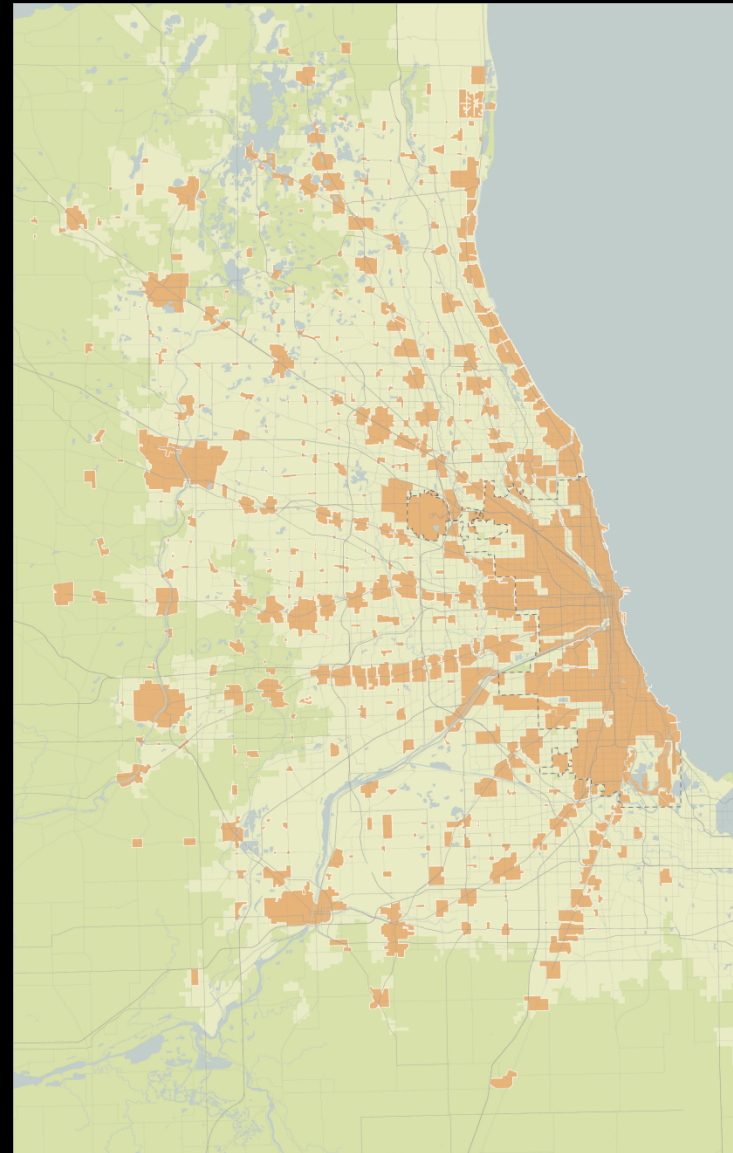

City Sector Plan

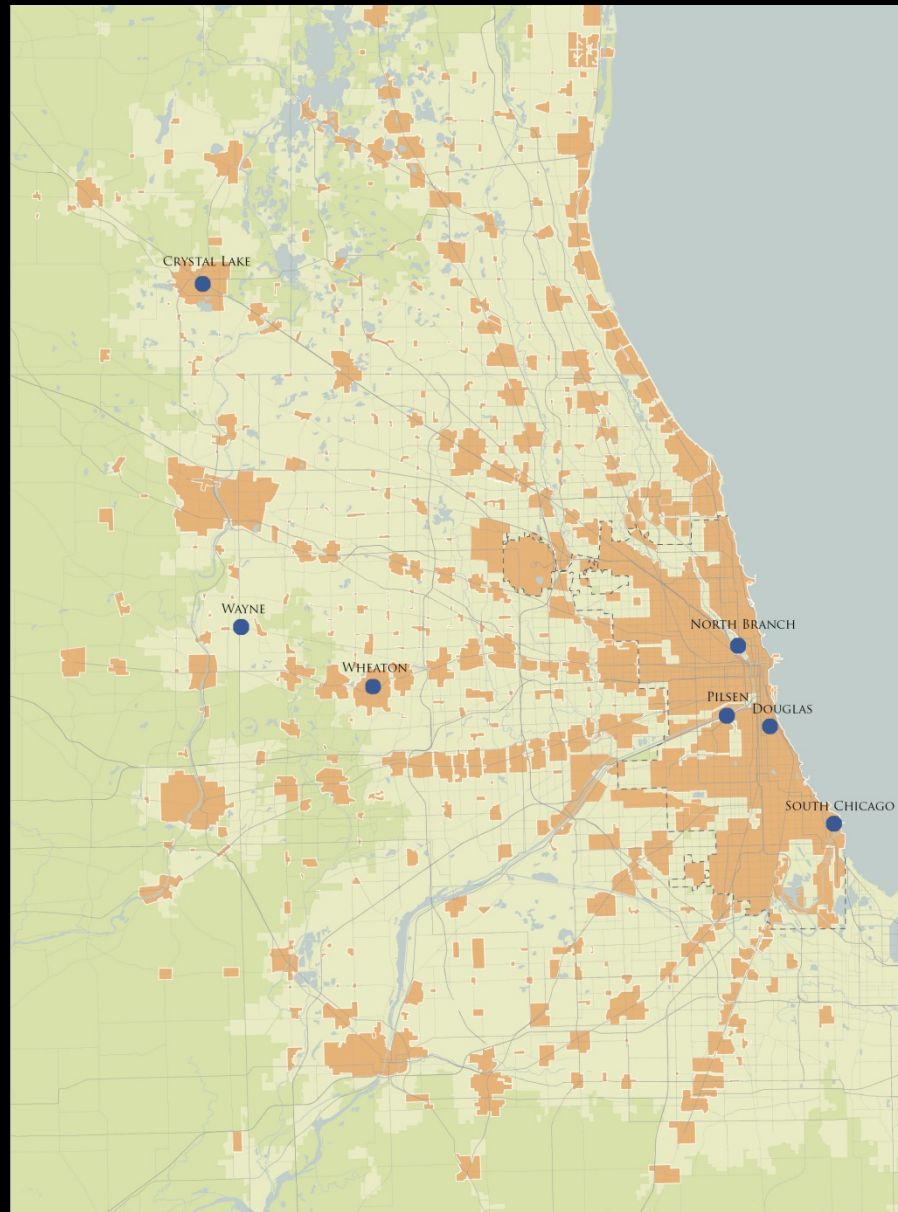
